

Project Proposal – Supporting The Climate Collective Village at Haslemere Charter Fair

Background

Several local organisations (including Transition Haslemere, Love Haslemere Hate waste, St. Stephens Church Eco-group and Eco-School Groups) have booked pitches as part of a Climate Collective Village at Haslemere Charter Fair.

About Surrey Amphibian and Reptile Group (SARG)

SARG has been advising the public, Councils and land-managers on the Conservation of UK's native reptiles and amphibians for the last 30 years. We have done this by attending shows and for 3-4 years attended and helped support an annual Wild Fire Event that the Haslemere Fire Station in collaboration with National Trust organised both at the Station and at the Devil's Punchbowl. SARG bring live wild animals to shows as a way to educate the public on their conservation. For the Climate Collective Village we will put together a Wild Fire display which will show the impact that wild fires on heathland have on this important habitat and our reptile fauna, which could get much worse due to predicted Global Warming.

The Project Proposal

This project proposal is to support the Climate Collective by having several Biodiversity Groups (Surrey Amphibian and Reptile Group and Surrey Dormice Group) and to hire-in a Solar Sound System with Pop-up Stage and Generator. The aim of the proposal is to attract visitors to Climate Collective Village. The pop-up stage will include an acoustic set, with groups invited to play after they have played on the main stage in the Charter Fair. Climate Collective stalls will also be invited to use the stage for talks to highlight their initiatives. A full itinerary will be developed with Haslemere Events prior to the Fair

Breakdown of costs and total grant request

1. The cost of four pitches is £180 (@ £45 per pitch, as required by Haslemere Events):
 - a. SARG and SDG requiring one pitch each, x2 pitches @ £90
 - b. The Pop-up stage requiring x2 pitches @ £90
2. The cost of the solar-power sound system and pop-up stage is £500, to be supplied by Jellytree Productions (www.jellytreetv.com)
 - a. Trailer pop-up stage (with small 12 pa) @ £200
 - b. Daisy Solar Sound-System @ £50
 - c. Logistics / set-up @ £100
 - d. SOL1 Generator @ £250

Total Costs = £780
