

Highways update

Reported issues from previous Planning & Highways Committee meetings not yet dealt with

Issues raised at August meeting are as follows:

- 1) Haslemere: Border Road to Border End is one big pothole. Needs to be reported but there is a query as to whether the road is private so SCC may not have responsibility. 1311524. It's not highway. Border End is a private unmade-up road. Highway starts outside no.1 Border Road.
- 2) Request to see the gully cleaning schedule from SCC. 1311554. This is not possible, all gully data is stored on our mapping system, if you have specific gullies you wish to know when they are scheduled I can find out.
- 3) Haslemere: Tanners Lane – can a refuge be installed in Tanners Lane to assist with people crossing what can a very fast road – Adrian Selby don't believe there is sufficient carriageway width to install a refuge at this location. A suitably sized refuge could only be installed on roads with a width in excess of 10-11m. Tanners Lane is showing a width of approximately 7 - 7.5m. Also, the cost of providing a refuge would be in excess of 20k.
